The word of God says life is brief:

What is your life? It is even a vapour, that appeareth for a little time, and then vanisheth away. James 4v14

We are all born with an everlasting soul, which will continue to exist after this life:

Man dieth... and where is he? Job 14v10

God leaves us in no doubt about where we will be in eternity.

As sinners before a Holy and perfect God, we deserve eternal punishment if we die in our sins:

For all have sinned, and come short of the glory of God. Romans 3v23

The wicked shall be turned into hell. Psalm 9v17

Yet God loves us, and desires to save us from eternal punishment:

For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life.

John 3v16

But God commendeth his love toward us, in that, while we were yet sinners, Christ died for

us. Romans 5v8

God sent His Son, the Lord Jesus Christ, into this world to die on our behalf. He bore our sins on the cross that we might obtain forgiveness from God and be with Him in heaven when life is over.

For Christ also hath once suffered for sins, the just for the unjust, that he might bring us to

God. 1 Peter 3v18

He that believeth on the Son hath everlasting life. John 3v36

“Time is short...” (1 Corinthians 7v29),

Now is the day of salvation... (2 Corinthians 6v2)

Believe on the Lord Jesus Christ and thou shalt be saved. (Acts 16v31)

For the Lord Jesus Christ said:
