The The Treatest Gift

The gift of God is eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord.

What is the Gift?

A gift is not something that we work for or pay for: it is free of charge, offered to us by someone who cares for us. God offers to each one of us the greatest gift we can ever receive: eternal life!

We have all done wrong in the sight of a Holy God. This is why He says, "there is none good, no, not one." and "all have sinned and come short of the glory of God." (Romans 3/128.23)

Our sin deserves death and eternal punishment in hell, but God offers us forgiveness from every sin, peace with Him and eternal life in heaven. Best of all: it's a gift! We cannot earn it by good deeds nor religious acts, but must accept it by faith:

"Therefore being justified by faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ."

Who offers the Gift?

A thoughtful gift demonstrates the love of the giver. We do not deserve eternal life, but God loves us and does not want to punish us for our sins. The Bible tells us:

"God so loved the world, that He gave His only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in Him should not perish, but have everlasting life." John 3V16

The God of Heaven, who made all things, cares so much for us that He gave His only Son, the Lord Jesus Christ, to die on our behalf. On the cross the Lord Jesus bore the punishment for our sins and on the third day God raised Him from the dead. The gift of eternal life comes from a living Saviour!

"For Christ also hath once suffered for sins, the Just for the unjust, that he might bring us to God." 1st Peter 3v18

How can I receive the Gift?

If you want the gift of God, the knowledge that your sins are forgiven and the assurance of a place in heaven, then you must admit your sin before God and accept by faith the Lord Jesus Christ as your Saviour.

"For by grace are ye saved through faith; and that not of yourselves: it is the gift of God: Not of works, lest any man should boast."
